They are there for extra practice and fun.</p> <p>All day kindergarteners are encouraged to do the <b>ALL DAY KINDERGARTEN</b> assignments (developed for the all day kindergarteners), but they are not required. Half day kinders are welcome to do these assignments as extension and challenge work if they choose to, but again, these are not required.</p> <p>The orange <b>JUST FOR FUN</b> section (at the very bottom of the lesson) is not an assignment, but rather cool things we found that your child might enjoy doing.</p> |
| <p>ELA-Reading</p>   | <p><a href="#">Today's Welcome Video - Mrs. Dow</a><br/> <a href="#">Today's Welcome Video- Mrs. Tomlinson</a></p> <p>Have your student listen to the attached <a href="#">read aloud</a> about the moon. Ask your student to tell you what they learned about the moon's gravity and how that gravity affects things on earth and on the moon.</p> <p>Log into your <a href="#">A-Z account</a>, (see parent letters sent via email for directions on how to access). Have your student listen to, read and take a quiz for one book in their Level Up portal. If you are having trouble logging in, email your child's teacher for assistance.</p> <p>Students will work in Lexia for 20-25 minutes. Lexia can be accessed through <a href="#">Clever</a>. | Math   | <p>Students will watch this <a href="#">Eureka Math Lesson 5.20</a></p> <p>While the video teacher is working through the math problems, have your student follow along and write the number bonds as she is teaching. Complete the Exit Ticket on the video by writing the numbers sentence to match the number bond the teacher gave.</p> <p>Have your student practice by writing a number bond where 13 is the whole number and fill in the 2 numbers that are the part? Do the same with the number 15, and 11. After completing the number bonds, write a number sentence for each.</p> <p>Application Problem: Each student was given 6 crayons and 4 pencils. How many did each student get of both? Draw a picture and number bond, then write a number sentence.</p> <p>Students will work in Zearn for 10 minutes today. Zearn can be accessed through <a href="#">Clever</a>. The Zearn app is the yellow square with the blue/white letter Z. This is a fun and easy to use program kinders are now able to use to practice the math skills we are learning..</p> |
