<b>MUST DO</b>	<u>Every</u> kindergarten student (both half day and all day) should be doing the <b>MUST DO</b> yellow assignments and submitting the assignments that are yellow and bolded in the <a href="#">Kindergarten Assignment Submission Link</a> on a daily basis.

<p><b>CAN DO</b></p> <p><b>ALL DAY KINDERGARTEN</b></p> <p><b>JUST FOR FUN</b></p>	<p>All kindergarteners are encouraged to do the <b>CAN DO</b> assignments, but they are not required. They are there for extra practice.</p> <p>All day kindergarteners are encouraged to do the <b>ALL DAY KINDERGARTEN</b> assignments (developed for the all day kindergarteners), but they are not required. Half day kinders are welcome to do these assignments as extension and challenge work if they choose to, but again, these are not required.</p> <p>The orange <b>JUST FOR FUN</b> section (at the very bottom of the lesson) is not an assignment, but rather cool things we found that your child might enjoy doing.</p>
<p>ELA-Reading</p>	<p><a href="#">Today's Welcome Video - Mrs. Dow's class</a>  <a href="#">Today's Welcome Video - Mrs. Tomlinson's class</a></p> <p><a href="#">Daily Heggerty Lesson</a></p> <p>Students will work in Lexia for 20-25 minutes. Lexia can be accessed through <a href="#">Clever</a>. Here are directions on how to <a href="#">access Clever</a>.</p> <p>Have your child listen to this fictional read aloud of <a href="#">Life on Mars</a>. After listening to the book, have your child to describe what Mars looks like in the story. Ask them if the boy finds any life on Mars besides himself?</p> <p>Log into your <a href="#">A-Z account</a>, (see parent letters sent via email for directions on how to access). Have your student listen to, read and take a quiz for one book in their Level Up portal. If you are having trouble logging in, email your child's teacher for assistance.</p>
<p>ELA-Writing</p>	<p>Writing Sight Word Sentence Stems "I like the" pt. 1. Have your child watch this <a href="#">video</a> (they will be writing sight word sentences along with Mrs. Dow). They will need a wipe board and marker or a paper and pencil.</p> <p><b>Submission assignment today, take a picture of your sight word sentences that you write while watching Mrs. Dow's video and submit it in the link below.</b></p> <p><a href="#">Mrs. Dow's Kindergarten Assignment Submission Link</a></p> <p><a href="#">Mrs. Tomlinson's Kindergarten Assignment Submission Link</a></p> <p>Write one more sentence from the stems Mrs. Dow gave you.</p>

	<p>Don't forget the uppercase letter and the beginning of the sentence, finger spacing, and punctuation at the end.</p>
<p>Math</p>	<p>Students will watch this <a href="#">Eureka Math Lesson 5.21</a></p> <p>While the video teacher is working through the math problems, have your student follow along and play the teen number game. Complete the Exit ticket by writing the number sentence down. Continue the practice by filling in a number bond of 12 as the whole and 10 in one part, what would be in the other part. Then write the number sentence for that problem. Follow the same procedure for numbers 15, and 17.</p> <p>Application Problem: Peter saw 8 puppies at the pet store. While he was watching them 2 hid in a box. How many puppies could Peter see then? Draw a picture, write a number bond and number sentence to match.</p> <p>Students will work in Zearn for 10 minutes today. Zearn can be accessed through <a href="#">Clever</a>. The Zearn app is the yellow square with the blue/white letter Z. This is a fun and easy to use program kinders are now able to use to practice the math skills we are learning.</p>
<p>Science/Social Studies</p>	<p><a href="#">BrainPop Jr. - Mars</a></p> <p>Watch <a href="#">this video</a> about Mars.</p> <p>Tell an adult why Mars is called "The Red Planet."</p>
<p>Just for Fun</p>	<p><b>Walk or run every day and be a part of Longview's Fun Run!
